Acceptable examples include: libraries, museums, fire companies, ambulance companies, schools, hospitals, medical centers, churches, scouting activities, animal shelters, Red Cross, foundations and other suitable 'community' organizations (parks, sports fields, etc.). **Non-acceptable service work would be 'volunteering' to assist/help a for-profit business no matter how small = Hours do NOT count IF that business entity takes in money for profit!
