ATTENTION STUDENTS: The board of directors of the Glendale Education Foundation is streamlining what will now only be acceptable “Community Service” work—to better align with what is approved as service work in the high school years. ****Beginning June 1, 2018** the Foundation will ONLY accept work hours that have been accomplished for normal, conventional **nonprofit or not-for-profit organizations** (or corporations). Acceptable examples include: libraries, museums, fire companies, ambulance companies, schools, hospitals, medical centers, churches, scouting activities, animal shelters, Red Cross, foundations and other suitable ‘community’ organizations (parks, sports fields, etc.). ****Non-acceptable service work** would be ‘volunteering’ to assist/help a **for-profit business** no matter how small = Hours do NOT count IF that business entity takes in money for profit!
