SELECTION CRITERIA

- ❖ Annual Award of **\$1,000.00** The funding for this scholarship award, given in memory of former Glendale High School technical education teacher, Mr. **Jack Burmeister**, exists from a private source and is distributed through the Glendale School District Education Foundation
- ❖ Candidate must be a Glendale High School senior student accepted into *any career focused vocational education (trade or technical) school* with the intention of completing degree requirements to acquire their **academic** certificate in their specific trade/career and/or to earn an **Associate in Arts (or Science) for Transfer Degree program** toward a career as a skilled tradesman or technician (**AS-T or AT-T degree*)

OR

Candidate is accepted into a **4-year university degree program in Education: Teacher preparation in the area of Industrial Arts/Technical Education** leading to an initial level of proficiency (Instructional I certificate)

- ❖ Candidate has completed the “*Local Scholarship Information Form*” as determined by the guidance office.
 - ❖ Candidate must have earned an overall minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of **85%** average—up to and including the next-to-last grading period of his/her senior year.
 - ❖ The student awarded this annual scholarship will have it presented at the high school “Academic Honors Night” near the end of the academic year. *The check for \$1,000.00 from the Glendale Education Foundation will be made payable to both the student *and* the post-graduate vocational school or university.
