- ✓ Annual Award: \$1,000.00 one time award
- ✓ Candidate must be a Glendale High School graduating senior student
- ✓ Candidate must be accepted with plans to attend an accredited educational institution to pursue a degree in one of the following majors: pre-law, criminal justice, criminology, law enforcement, paralegal/legal assistant, or any other major that is deemed acceptable by the scholarship committee.
- ✓ Preference will be given to students pursuing a bachelor's or associate's degree.
- ✓ Candidate must have earned an overall minimum GPA (grade point average) of 90%--- [\*Up to and including 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 week period of senior year].
- ✓ Candidate will complete an essay (no more than 2 pages typed and double spaced) to answer the following:
  - Why do you want to pursue a career in pre-law, criminal justice, or paralegal/legal assistant?
  - What special attributes do you have that will assist you in reaching your career goal?
  - What are the most important issues your field is facing today?

These essays will be judged on their content by a committee including the superintendent, high school principal, high school assistant principal, guidance counselor and a member of the school board--- the winner will be announced at the annual scholarship awards evening in May.
