Criteria Checklist for the Glendale Education Foundation's

Dr. Edward B. Turchick Scholarship

- 1. Student must be a Grade 12 student of Glendale Junior-Senior High School who meets/exceeds this mandatory criteria:
 - who is accepted/enrolled in a (minimum) two-year accredited post-high school institute of higher learning/university
 - has a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 85% by the end of the first semester of their senior year.
 - has completed the "Local Scholarship Information Form" as determined by the guidance office.
- 2. Student will complete a minimum of <u>20</u> hours on an autonomous *Project* that enhances and impacts the *community or school* in some manner.
- 3. The project must be done *independently* by the student himself/herself---not part of a group activity.
- 4. The student will thoughtfully fill-out a 9-question *Project Questionnaire*—detailing their reasons, goals, benefits and perceived impact of the community/school project.
- 5. The student will present a short (3-5 minute) *Project Presentation* to the (3-member) Scholarship Committee of the Glendale Education Foundation—further describing their project.
- 6. <u>Final</u> determination: the Scholarship/Evaluation Committee of the Glendale School District Education Foundation will make the final choice for the scholarship recipient based on the positive overall *impact* of the student's <u>project</u> on the community—as determined by:
 - the student's project presentation
 - the student's self-evaluation / questionnaire
 - satisfaction of all the above criteria checklist
- 7. The Dr. Edward B. Turchick Scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000.00.
- 8. Winner of the Glendale Education Foundation's *Dr. Edward B. Turchick Scholarship* will be presented a bank check for \$1,000 from the Foundation account written out in his/her name <u>and</u> the name of the higher institution/university to which the student has matriculated. The winner will be awarded his/her scholarship at the annual Scholarship Program in May.
