- ✤ Annual Award: \$250.00 The funding for this academic scholarship exists from private sources distributed by the Glendale School District Education Foundation.
- Candidate must be a Glendale High School senior student accepted into any *career focused* post-secondary Vocational / Technical / Trade School -- with the intention of completing the degree requirements to acquire their academic certificate in their specific trade. [*This may include achieving either an AA-T Degree (Associate in Arts) or AS-T Degree (Associate in Science)]
- ✤ Candidate has completed the mandatory "*Local Scholarship Information Form*" by the deadline determined by the high school guidance office.
- Candidate must have earned an overall minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 85% —up to and including the next-to-last grading period of his/her senior year.
- ★ *Special preference given to a candidate who was a GHS student attending the GACTC (*Greater Altoona Career & Technology Center*)—in the manufacturing or construction industry programs.
- The student awarded this annual scholarship will have it presented at the high school "Academic Honors Night" near the end of the academic year. "The check for \$250.00 from the Glendale Education Foundation will be made payable to <u>both</u> the student *and* the vocational/technical school.
