- ✓ Candidate must be a Glendale High School graduating senior student
- ✓ Candidate must be accepted with plans to attend an accredited career/vocational school or university enrolled in a *health*-related field. (nursing, physician's assistant, pre-med).
- ✓ Candidate must have earned an overall minimum GPA (grade point average) of 88%-*up to and including the 3rd nine week period of their senior year.
- ✓ Candidate will complete an essay (no more than 2 pages, typed and double spaced) to articulately answer the following questions:
 - How do you or will you overcome obstacles in your personal and professional life?
 - What are the most important issues your field is facing today?
 - Explain the importance of obtaining a health career in today's society.

These essays will be judged primarily on their content by the Glendale Education Foundation scholarship committee

The winning candidate will be awarded the *Katie M. Flick Memorial Scholarship* at the Glendale High School's annual awards ceremony in May. A check courtesy of the Glendale Education Foundation for \$250.00 will be made out to both the student and to the school. This check can then be turned into the Bursar's Office at the school when they begin to matriculate to apply the funds toward their education.
