
The Paul W. Winslow Memorial Scholarship
SELECTION CRITERIA

- ❖ Annual Award: **\$ 1,000.00**. The funding for this academic scholarship exists from a private source and operates through the Glendale School District Education Foundation.
 - ❖ Candidate must be a Glendale High School senior student accepted/matriculated into a **4-year university** degree program **OR** into a **2-year** technical/vocational school.
 - ❖ Candidate must be a student who desires to major in any of these (two) primary (**4-year**) Undergraduate Academic Areas:
 - **Education**
 - Teacher preparation in any specialty degree program leading to an initial level of proficiency (Instructional I certificate) in any K-12 undergraduate major.
 - OR**
 - **Science:**
 - *Including:* Biological/Life Science; Earth & Mineral Science; Environmental Science; Agricultural/Plant Science; Computer/Informational Science; Engineering (Aerospace, Chemical, Civil, Mechanical, Petroleum, etc.); Physics, etc.
- OR**
- Candidate must be a student who desires to major in *any* curricular area of a **2-year Technical/Vocational** School.
- ❖ Candidate must have earned an overall minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of **90%** (or “B”) average—up to and including the next-to-last grading period of his/her senior year
 - ❖ Student must show evidence that he/she has completed a minimum of **15 hours** of **community service** (*signed by the entities and affirmed by the guidance office of the high school)
 - ❖ The student awarded this annual scholarship will have it presented at the high school “Academic Honors Night” near the end of the academic year. *The check for \$1,000.00 from the Glendale Education Foundation will be made payable to **both** the student *and* the university entity.
