The Randal P. Reese Memorial Scholarship

- Annual Award: \$300 (* beginning year May 2010)
- Candidate must be matriculating to an accredited four-year university.
- Candidate must be a Glendale High School graduating senior student who desires to major on the university level to achieve a Bachelor's degree in either:
 - o Elementary Education (any levels K-6) or
 - o Library Science or
 - School Counselor
- Candidate must have earned an overall minimum G.P.A. (grade point average) of <u>90%</u> [*up to and including the 3rd nine week grading period of their senior year].
- Student applicant will complete an **essay** [*no more than 2 pages, typed, double-spaced] to articulately answer either <u>one</u> of these questions depending on your career choice:
 - o 'Why I want to have a career as an elementary school teacher? (or)
 - o 'Why I want to have a career as a school librarian? (or)
 - o 'Why I want to have a career as a school counselor?
 - These essays will be *blind-judged* primarily on their content by the Glendale Education Foundation scholarship committee.
- The winning student is awarded this *Randal P. Reese Memorial Scholarship* at the Glendale High School's annual "Scholarship Program" in mid-May. A check from the Glendale Education Foundation for \$300.00, will be made out to *both* the student *and* their chosen higher education facility.
