- ❖ Annual Award: \$1,000.00. The funding for this academic scholarship exists from a private source and operates through the Glendale School District Education Foundation.
- Candidate must be a Glendale High School senior student accepted/matriculated into a 4-year university degree program
- Candidate must be a student who desires to major in any of these (two) primary (4-year) Undergraduate Academic Areas:

Chemical, Civil, Mechanical, Petroleum, etc.); Physics, etc.

OR

Education

- Teacher preparation in any specialty degree program leading to an initial level of proficiency (Instructional I certificate) in any K-12 undergraduate major.
- Candidate must have earned an overall minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 90% (or "B") average—up to and including the next-to-last grading period of his/her senior year
- * Extra credit if candidate is a member of the school's *National Honor Society*.
