SELECTION CRITERIA

- ❖ Annual Award: **\$500.00** The funding for this academic scholarship exists from private sources deposited in the accounts of--and operated through--the Glendale School District Education Foundation.
 - ❖ Candidate must be a Glendale High School senior student accepted into any *career focused Vocational / Technical / Trade School* -- with the intention of completing the degree requirements to acquire their **academic certificate** in their specific trade. [and/or earning--where applicable--an *Associate in Arts* or *Associate in Science degree*]
 - ❖ Candidate has completed the “*Local Scholarship Information Form*” by a deadline determined by the guidance office.
 - ❖ Candidate must have earned an overall minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of **85%** average—up to and including the next-to-last grading period of his/her senior year.
 - ❖ **First Preference** will be given to student candidate(s) majoring in the **Machinist** Trade.
 - ❖ **Next Preferences** will be given to student candidate(s) majoring in any of these particular trades: **Welding, HVAC, or Mechanic** Trades.
 - ❖ The student awarded this scholarship will have it presented at the high school “Academic Honors Night” near the end of the academic year. *The check for **\$500.00** from the Glendale Education Foundation will be made payable to both the student *and* the vocational/technical school.
